





How can I view my child's Semester 2 Academic Report?

In 2023 we will no longer be utilising Class dojo for school communications and messaging.

It will still be used for individual student points and rewards.

Why are we saying goodbye to dojo?

- To reduce the number of apps families are required to use.
- To bring us in line with local secondary schools (the majority of which use Compass) and make the transition from primary to secondary easier.



How will I be able to send my child's teacher a message?


How To: Email a Teacher

To email your child's teachers, click the option listed under the name on your dashboard.




This will open the email box with all your child's teachers pre-loaded as recipients.

Remove any teachers that the email is not relevant to by clicking the red cross next to their name.




How will I be able to send my child's teacher a message?
