



On Friday the 4th of August our Prep's will celebrate reaching 100 days of school! They have been keeping track of their school days in the classroom each morning.



1A & 1B Snapshot

Everyone has been loving learning about different countries around the world! We have been working so well together to make Papier-mâché globes. You can see the progress with them so far! Lots of patience and teamwork was shown! It has been so lovely seeing everyone's interest spark with the world around us. Lots of questions have been asked! We have been learning about Italy and some of the famous historical sites such as the Colosseum, Pompeii and the Leaning Tower of Pisa. We even practised how to say 'Italy' in Auslan.











4/5 B Snapshot

This week in 4/5B we have been learning about erosion. We have been reading non-fiction texts to learn what erosion is and the impact erosion has on people and the environment.

Students learnt about the importance of vegetation (trees and plants) in holding soil in place to stop wind and water erosion. To test this theory we went outside to the sandpit in the yard. To begin the experiment, students saw what occurred when wind (air from a filled balloon) pushes against sand. Students then used objects from the environment (mud, sticks, leaves, rocks, stones and grass) to prevent the sand from being eroded away by the "wind".
